Enjoying a rural setting in a sought-after location, this compact block of land with versatile building is ideally suited for agricultural and rural activities, whilst also offering further development opportunities subject to necessary consents. Located less than 2 miles from the Bogenraith Equestrian Centre, the property also has excellent equestrian potential. The property benefits from roadside access and is conveniently located a short distance from the B979, within easy reach of Aberdeen and Stonehaven. within easy reach of Aberdeen and Stonehaven.

The land extends to 6 hectares (15 acres) or thereby and is split into three fields, presently down to grass providing quality grazing and silage. The land is classified as Grade 3(2) by the James Hutton Institute, capable of productive grass and arable production. The land is stockproof fenced and waterings are provided from the burn on the north boundary.

The steel portal frame agricultural building measures c. 30m x 10m and is divided into two internal sections and an open barn area. The building provides excellent storage and workshop space however can be used for livestock or adapted for other purposes, subject to obtaining necessary consent. There is a good-sized hardstanding yard area and gated access from the public road. The shed is not presently connected to services however water is available via rainwater collection to storage tanks and services are understood to be available nearby.
